Communion Service

The communion service customarily is celebrated once per quarter. The service includes foot-washing followed by the Lord's Supper. It should be a most sacred and joyous occasion to the congregation.

Why we wash each other's feet (Ordinance of foot-washing)

This act of washing one another's feet follows the Biblical example set by Jesus when he washed the disciples' feet. By doing so, we honour Jesus' instruction, 'I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.' This ordinance is Christ's appointed preparation for communion service. While pride, jealousy, and strife for supremacy are cherished, the heart cannot enter into fellowship with Christ. We are not prepared to receive the communion of His body and His blood. Therefore it was that Jesus appointed the act that reminds us of His example in humility to be observed first.

Next communion we will cover the bread and the wine used for Communion.
